About the Workshop

LGBTIQ+ Christian leaders training for contextual Queer LGBTIQ+ Christians in their communities. (max. Theologies and pastoral care relevant to their communities.

Organizations

QTA: Founded in 2009, its mission is to develop and practice queer theology and gender justice within Hong Kong. We aim to promote justice and equal rights for people with different sexual orientations through publishing and education.

DSCCC: Established in 1963, it is presently a theological education institution jointly supported by four denominations and located at the Chinese University of Hong Kong.

Features

- 1. The workshop will examine contemporary LGBTIQ+ issues in the public arena through the lens of queer biblical and theological reflection, while also exploring queer pastoral care and spirituality.
- 2. The most unique aspect of the workshop is the whole person approach to learning: intellectually (lectures and tutorials for queer theology and exegesis), spiritually (meditation and inclusive worship to understand different sexual orientations), and ethically (understanding the struggles of sexual minorities encouraging and establishment of inclusive systems within their own communities).
- 3. Mentorship program will be available to participants after the summer workshop.

Content (All programs in Cantonese & Putonghua) 6 days + 5 nights summer camp, including:

- Introduction of general knowledge about Feminist/Queer Theologies, Queer biblical studies, Sexual Ethics and history in the Christian LGBTIQ+ movement.
- Creating an inclusive liturgy, sermon, or Bible study resource material on a topic relating to Queer Theology and pastoral care, cultivating spirituality through a series of training.

Target

Queer Theology Academy (QTA) will hold a Queer Theology Priority will be given to applicants who are LGBTIQ+ Christian Summer workshop with the support of Divinity School of pastors and leaders from East and South East Asia who are Chung Chi College, CUHK (DSCCC). This workshop provides currently committed to a ministry providing pastoral care for participants)
